

# Navarro County Open Invitational Youth Judging Contests

## Livestock Judging and Consumer Decision Making

<b>Early Registration by March 25, 2019</b> .....	\$20.00 per team and \$10.00 per individual
<b>Late Fee Registration (at the Contest)</b> .....	\$25.00 per team and \$15.00 per individual

All contests will be held **Friday, March 29, 2019**. Registration confirmation for all contests will take place at the Navarro County Expo Center located on West Hwy 22 in Corsicana, Texas.

Registration confirmation for the Livestock Judging Contest will be held from 8:00AM to 8:45 AM in the Fannie Mae Vernon Room located at the Navarro County Expo Center. The contest will begin at approximately 9:00AM. Registration for the Consumer Decision Making (CDM) Contest will be held from 9:00AM to 9:30AM at the Navarro County Expo Center (Fannie Mae Vernon Room). The CDM Contest will start at 10:00AM in the Fannie Mae Vernon Room.

A **Free Lunch** for all contestants and coaches will be provided starting at 12:00 PM and official results will be announced at approximately 1:00 PM at The IOOF Event Center (601 North 45<sup>th</sup> Street, Corsicana, TX

Each FFA Chapter, 4-H Club, or FCCLA may enter as many teams as they wish. Each Livestock Judging and Consumer Decision Making team will be comprised of 3 or 4 members with the 3 highest scores used for tabulations. Single individuals may also register for these contests. **All participants must be in compliance with UIL regulations.** Cell phones, mechanical devices, and talking will not be allowed during the contests. Any infraction of contest rules may result in team and individual disqualification.
